SafeSpot provides virtual spotting services to people who use drugs to prevent overdose. An individual using drugs alone calls the line, uses the substance, and stays in verbal communication with the operator until both the caller and the operator have decided that they are safe to disconnect. If there is an emergency, the operator will call the designated responder given by the caller or emergency response services.
